Requirements:

- Interactive, energetic, and student centered teaching style
- Ability to keep a flexible work schedule

Responsibilities:

Spanish Tutors work directly with Rory & Leslie Foster in establishing the syllabus and outlining course objectives for clients, but tutor is responsible for the details of the classes (planning, contact with students' teachers, follow-up communication with students, etc.)

Other Details:

- Starting pay is \$30 per tutoring hour (planning, prep, and coordination time not compensated additionally)
