- 1. Travel may be arranged by **CGI**, a travel agent, or myself; and that all transportation and services are subject to the laws of the countries visited. All prices are based on current tariffs and current exchange rates and are subject to confirmation and adjustment.
- 2. I acknowledge that international travel involves risks, which include the potential for death, serious bodily injury, or property loss.
- 3. I agree to hold harmless **CGI**, including its officers, agents, employees, representatives, and successors, from any liability arising from my participation in the Spanish Immersion Trip including without limitation any injury, loss, damage, accident, delay, irregularity, or expense arising from use of a vehicle or other services arising from:
 - a. strikes, war, weather, quarantine, sickness, terrorists actions, government restrictions, or regulations; or
 - b. any act or omission of any ship, airline, railroad, sight-seeing, hotel, transportation company; or
 - c. any wrongful, negligent, or unauthorized acts or omissions on the part of any of the suppliers; or
 - d. any wrongful, negligent, or unauthorized acts or omissions on the part of any employee of any of these suppliers; or
 - e. any defect in or failure of any vehicle, equipment, or instrument owned, operated or otherwise used by any of these suppliers; or
 - f. any wrongful or negligent acts or omissions on the part of any other party not under the supervision and control, direct or otherwise, of **CGI**, its officers or agents; or
 - g. any self directed/planned activities/travel that I choose to undertake before, during, or after the trip.
- 4. I realize that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their possible liability without fault.
- 5. In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this trip, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows:

- (A) Waive, Release and Discharge from any and all liability for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter occur to me including my traveling to and from Costa Rica THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OR PERSONS: COMMON GROUND INTERNATIONAL, LLC; RORY FOSTER, LESLIE FOSTER, TRIP LEADERS and, ANY OTHER COMMON GROUND EMPLOYEE; and
- (B) Indemnify and Hold Harmless the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made as a result of participation in this event, whether caused by the negligence of releases or otherwise.
- 6. I hereby give permission to Common Ground International the authority to seek medical care on my child's behalf to receive medical treatment, which is advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during this trip.
- 7. I understand that the **CGI** trip reserves the right, in its sole discretion to cancel or discontinue the trip (in which event refund of deposit may be made) or to make such alternations in the itinerary as is necessary or desirable.
- 8. I agree that I will be fully responsible for my luggage and personal effects; provide the Trip Director with all my personal travel arrangements, medical insurance arrangements while a member of the Trip; and provide the Trip Director with complete information if I make accommodation changes.
- 9. This Participant Liability Waiver Form shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law. I hereby certify that I have read this document; and, I understand its content.
- 10. Any and all disputes arising from or relating (in any way) to this trip shall be subject to the laws of the State of Colorado and shall resolved exclusively pursuant to binding arbitration at the Office of Dispute Resolution in Denver, Colorado pursuant to the then current rules of the American Arbitration Association. The arbitrator's decision and award shall be binding upon both parties. No court shall have any subject matter jurisdiction for any suit at law or in equity based on any dispute, claim or controversy arising from or relating (in any way) to the CGI Spanish Immersion Trip instituted by either party, except to enforce the award of the arbitrator.

Spanish Immersion Behavior Contract

Parents:

We are looking forward to traveling with your son/daughter on their Spanish Immersion Exchange Program. Our goals for this trip are to learn, have fun, and stay safe. In order to make this possible, we ask for your support regarding our behavior policy:

Students:

As a program participant, you are representing the United States, Common Ground International, Peak to Peak High School and your family name! We expect your behavior to reflect that responsibility. This means exercising good judgment and keeping in mind that you are in another country and must be respectful of the local culture.

We also expect you to have a positive, encouraging attitude. You must be willing to take ahold of this wonderful opportunity and enjoy the experience. Sure, it is expected that you will have a hard day or a difficult time adjusting to certain aspects of immersion and we will be there for you to help you through this natural process, but please don't lead with negativity! This might just be a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

Your behavior should in no way endanger yourself or anyone else or have a negative impact on the group. If you experience a conflict or have a problem that you are unable to handle, we expect you to bring it to the attention of the program coordinator and trip leaders.

Students are required to abide by school rules (please see your school handbook) and Common Ground's no-tolerance policy (see below). Minor infractions will be dealt with on an individual basis and in an appropriate manner. However, serious offenses will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the trip and subsequent return to the United States at the parents' expense. Such offenses include:

- Falling out of contact with the student group and/or your host family
- Wandering away from the group and "sneaking out" at night
- Neglecting program obligations such as attending class and community service work
- Use of illegal drugs inluding vaping
- Use of alcohol
- Sexual activity
- A negative, non respectful attitude that is having a detrimental impact on the group as a whole
- Any action that endangers or could potentially endanger others
