

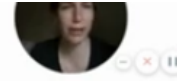

PRESENT SIMPLE / PRESENT CONTINUOUS

Present Simple	<p>Uses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To talk about routines, habits, and hobbies • To describe characteristics, traits, or qualities of a something • To describe the "state" of something • Often used with adverbs of frequency like <i>sometimes</i>, <i>always</i>, or <i>usually</i>

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Present Continuous

Present Progressive/Continuous:



Uses:

- To talk about things happening right now
- To talk about things happening right now that will continue for a length of time.
- To describe or tell a story about events in a still image or photo
- To talk about the future*

*We're not going to talk about this. :)

Form:

Present Continuous Form

Subject	Be verb	Verb+ing	...
I	am	teaching	a class.
He/She/It	is	working	right now.
You	are	*listening	to music.
We/They	are	*watching	a movie.

Common exceptions: like, dislike, hate, want, need
 Prefer, agree, disagree
