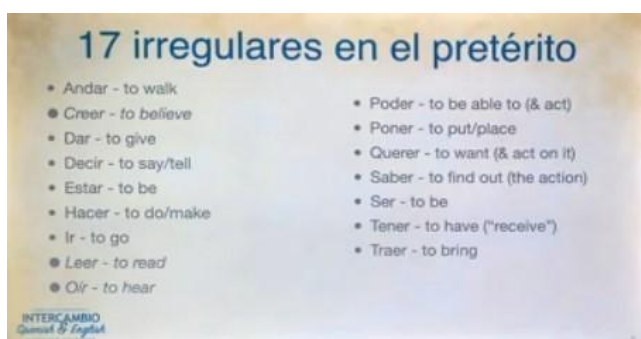

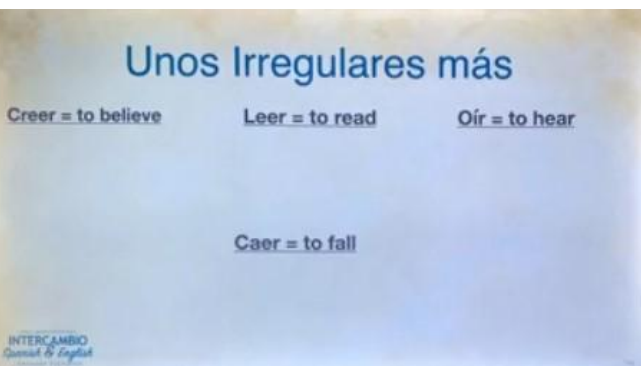
Irregular Verbs in the Past Tense

Simple Past: Irregular Verbs

Many common verbs are irregular in the simple past tense.

There is no simple rule. Many people just memorize them and practice a lot. :)

Be Verb		Other Examples	
am	was	eat → ate	Feel → felt
is	was	drink → drank	Keep → kept
are	were	Sit → sat	Sleep → slept
		Spend → spent	Put → put
		Bite → bit	Buy → bought
		go → went	Think → thought
		Leave → left	Tell → told



- There are no shortcuts or tricks for knowing or learning which verbs are irregular in the past tense or how they change.
- There is only one form in the simple past tense (except be), so you only need to memorize one form. :)
- Many frequently used verbs are irregular in the past tense.
