 - a. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I acknowledge and understand that participation in international travel involves a number of serious risks including, but not limited to, the following:

No court shall have any subject matter jurisdiction for any suit at law or in equity based on any dispute, claim or controversy arising from or relating (in any way) to the CGI Spanish Immersion Trip instituted by either party, except to enforce the award of the arbitrator.

Parents:

Our goals for this trip are to learn, have fun, stay safe and offer a once-in-a-lifetime experience for all travelers regardless of beliefs, identity, orientation and race. In order for this to happen, we need your support regarding our behavior policy.

Students:

As a program participant, you are representing the United States, Common Ground International, your high school, your community and your family name! We expect your behavior to reflect that responsibility. You will be living in another country and culture for a short period of time, please exercise good judgment and DO NOT participate in illegal activities. We ask that you be respectful of the local culture and other travelers on the program.

We also expect you to have a positive, encouraging and respectful attitude toward all of your fellow travelers, your trip leaders, your host family and others from the host culture. You must be willing to fully engage in this opportunity to enjoy the experience. You will have hard days, interesting experiences and possibly a difficult time adjusting to certain aspects of immersion. We will be there to help you through this natural process, but please don't lead with negativity!

To ensure an amazing and safe experience, your behavior should in no way disrespect others, endanger yourself or anyone else, nor have a negative impact on the group. If you experience a conflict or need help resolving a problem, we expect you to bring it to the attention of the program leaders.

You must not engage in illegal activity while on immersion. Participants are required to abide by local laws, respect and follow the guidelines and rules set forth for them at the language school, in their host families and Common Ground's no-tolerance policy. Minor infractions will be dealt with on an individual basis and in an appropriate manner. However, serious offenses such as those below will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the trip and subsequent return to the United States at the parent / guardian's expense. Such offenses include:

- Engaging in illegal activity in Costa Rica, Ecuador
- · Purchasing, posessing, or consuming illegal drugs (including marijuana and vaping) or alcohol while on program
- Sexual activity
- Sneaking out at night while living with host family or after "room-checks" at hotels
- Neglecting program obligations such as group activities, attending class, community service work, host family activities and meals, and check-in's with leaders
- A negative, disrespectful attitude that is having a detrimental impact on the group as a whole
- Any action that endangers or could potentially endanger others
